



SMALL-SCALE COMMERCIAL MODERN WOOD HEATING REBATE PROGRAM

PROJECT ELIGIBILITY*

In order to be eligible for a MassCEC small-scale commercial rebate, Projects must:

1. Be defined as a commercial, industrial, institutional, or public facility project installing a modern wood heating system with rated heating capacities up to 120,000 BTU/hr (10 heating tons)
2. Receive electricity service from Eversource, National Grid, Unitil, or one of the five [eligible municipal light plants](#).
3. Be at project sites that are occupied year-round.
4. Have an energy audit at the project site within the last four (4) years or plan to have one within the next 6 months. (To schedule a free home energy audit: www.masssave.com or 1-866-527-7283.)
5. Abide by all of the technical specifications, building code, and design guidelines outlined in the [Program Manual](#).
6. Wait to receive an award letter from MassCEC before ordering equipment or beginning construction.

GRANT AMOUNTS*

The rebate is calculated as a percentage of eligible project costs

The rebate structure is summarized in the table below:

	Base Rebate Amount	Thermal Storage Adder	Maximum Total Rebate
Private/For-Profit	40% of Eligible Project Costs, limited to \$20,000	100% of Thermal Storage Unit Installed Cost, limited to \$2,000	\$22,000
Public/Non-Profit/ Affordable Housing	50% of Eligible Project Costs, limited to \$25,000		\$27,000

HOW TO APPLY

1. Understand the program requirements,* determine eligibility for the non-profit/public entity or affordable housing adders.
2. Installer submits an Application and supporting materials** to biomassthermal@masscec.com on behalf of the system owner.
3. Wait for the Award Letter, then begin system installation.
4. Installer submits project completion materials to biomassthermal@masscec.com within four months of the award letter for projects at existing buildings and six months for new construction, this will release grant payment to the designated payee. The rebate payment may be paid directly to the installer, system owner, or manufacturer.

**A complete small-scale commercial application includes: a completed & submitted application form, a signed [Participant's Agreement](#), a copy of a recent month's electric bill showing the "service for" address and the commercial rate code, a summary report from the heat load calculation, a W-9, a tax-exempt certificate (if applicable), and documentation of rebate adders (if applicable).
